H&M to open second Inland-area store

Trendy fashion retailer H&M has signed a 10-year lease to open its second Inland store at The Shoppes at Chino Hills. The 400,000-square-foot, open-air lifestyle center is being developed at Grand Avenue and Peyton Drive, just west of Highway 71.

A statement from mall developer Opus West said the center is planned for completion in May and is 60 percent leased. An exact opening date for H&M has not been announced, but it will occupy a 10,475-square-foot space.

Sweden-based H&M (Hennes and Mauritz) opened its first Inland store last month at the Galleria at Tyler in Riverside. The retailer, which works with high-profile designers to offer moderately priced men's and women's fashions, was founded in 1947 and operates 1,400 stores in 28 countries.
